During the Goal Setting Stage of Phase II (Aug. 15, 2007 to Oct. 15, 2007), a few churches decided not to participate in the Forward in Their Footsteps Endowment Campaign for a variety of reasons. These are not included in the list of 121 participating churches. However, a few members of these churches have felt the call to join the effort to plant new congregations in the DSC with earnings from an endowment fund.
